



VTCT Hair and Beauty

COURSE OUTLINE:

This qualification has been developed for learners aged 14-16 with an interest in hairdressing and/or beauty therapy. This qualification is supported by non assessed practical elements.

Students will:

- Develop a broad understanding of the hair and beauty sector
- Develop knowledge of vocational sector and related industries
- Develop skills that will support progression within the hair and beauty sector and more broadly, across the range of sectors.

Note: this course has good links to business enterprise.

COURSE ASSESSMENT:

Unit 1 Understanding the hair and beauty sector (Exam Assessment)

Students are introduced to the wide variety of hair and beauty business. Students explore the many different business opportunities open to hair and beauty professionals while examining the scope of services and treatments on offer.

Unit 2: Hair and beauty research project (Internal Assessment)

Learners will produce a proposal for research into the hair and beauty sector, and will use this to carry out a hair and beauty research project. Learners will present their research and findings, as well as opportunities for

Unit 3 Hair and beauty science (Internal Assessment)

Developing your knowledge of the properties, functions and effects of key ingredients, and the chemical compositions of hair and beauty products.

Unit 4: Responding to a hair and beauty design brief

This unit will provide learners with an understanding of the design briefs that are commonplace in the hair and beauty sector. Learners will develop the knowledge to analyse design briefs, paying particular attention to the needs of clients and the demands of the brief.
